San Luis High School has adopted the Cambridge IGCSE Curriculum for students in all grades and utilizes AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) as its instructional platform. Our goal is for students to have the knowledge and skills necessary to go on to a successful college experience or career. Cambridge and AVID encourages learner centered and inquiry-based approaches to learning and develops learners’ skills in creative thinking, inquiry and problem solving, giving learners’ excellent preparation for the next stage in their education. Standards based grading systems are embedded throughout the curriculum, and most courses engage students in personalized learning and student choice.

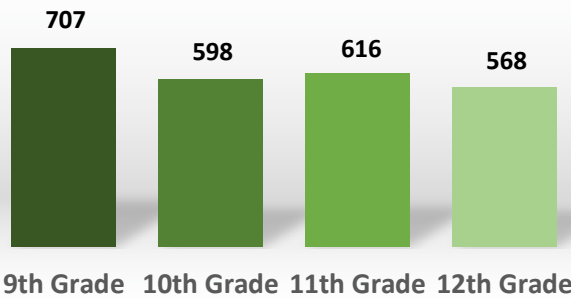

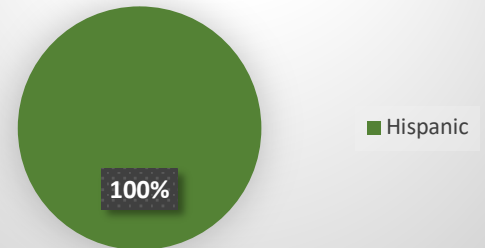

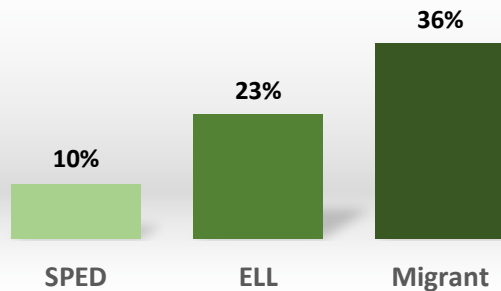
Student Population by Grade Level



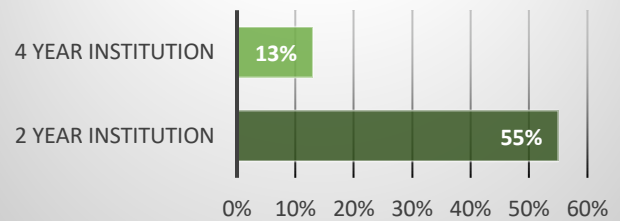
Race and Ethnicity
