

### **Class 1 –**

This category of user is exempt from Facilities Rental fees, but may be subject to any and all out-of-pocket expenses incurred by the District as a result of the use of the District's facilities. Groups in this class include, but are not limited to:

- District-sponsored staff and student groups, school teams, clubs or organizations
- District-sponsored AMEA/ABODA organizations – State Music organizations in which District students are involved.
- District-approved camps/clinics
- District-sponsored State/local student dance, theater or athletic associations comprised solely of District students.
- AIA league, region and state activities that involve District teams
- Teacher and staff organizations (New teacher orientation, teacher training, etc.)
- District departments conducting staff development, in-service or other job-related training classes for District personnel at the request of a District administrator.
- Employee organizations formed for the sole purpose of representing District employees.
- Those groups with whom the District has an existing IGA (Inter-Governmental Agreements sanctioned by YUHSD Governing Board and signed by the board's designee)

### **Class 2 –**

This class of user is exclusively for non-profit organizations (with proof of a letter of determination indicating 501c(3) status approved by the IRS) associated with Yuma Union High School District whose activities **directly** support the educational function of the District. This class is subject to minimal facility rental fees as indicated by accompanying Facility Rental Fee Table 1-01.

#### **Direct Support to District:**

- Parent-teacher organizations.
- Public colleges and universities that use school property to provide course instruction to District employees in a subject pertaining to K-12 education.
- Non-profit medical/dental organizations using school property to provide free or reduced-cost services to students who are AHCCCS-eligible and enrolled in a District school.
- Booster Clubs.
- Youth organizations such as Scouts, 4H, Boys and Girls Club, etc.
- Volunteer groups conducting activities for school-age children, who pay no fees to participate in the activity occurring on District premises. The persons conducting the activity are all volunteers, deriving no personal financial benefit. Examples include Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts of America, Campfire, Little League, Pop Warner, etc.
- Federal, State and Local Government organizations for which reciprocal agreements have been executed.



### **Class 3 –**

This class of user is exclusively for non-profit organizations (with proof of a letter of determination indicating 501c(3) status approved by the IRS) associated with Yuma Union High School District whose activities **indirectly** provide benefit to the District. This class is subject to reasonable facility rental fees as indicated by accompanying Facility Rental Fee Table 1-01.

#### **Indirect Benefit to District:**

- Public colleges and universities that use school property to provide course instruction to their students or to community groups.
- Student events comprised of YUHSD feeder school students.
- Community youth or adult sports leagues (Little League, Babe Ruth, WWFL, etc.)
- Community youth or adult performing arts groups (Theater, Dance, Music, etc.)
- Non-profit Youth Organizations, to include those not meeting the volunteer group criteria listed in Class 2 above (Boys/Girls Club, YMCA, Community Sports Leagues).
- Partnerships mutually beneficial to the District and the organization.
- AIA activities not involving District teams.

### **Class 4 –**

This class of user is exclusively for non-profit organizations (with proof of a letter of determination indicating 501c(3) status approved by the IRS) whose academic or recreational activities do not derive a financial benefit from the activity. This class of user will be charged a discounted facility rental fee and all personnel costs or other out-of-pocket costs incurred by the District as outlined in accompanying Facility Rental Fee Table 1-01.

- Federal, State and local governments or elected officials conducting community or official business within the district with no reciprocal agreements in place.
- Churches or religious organizations.
- Adult Civic Organizations such as Rotary, Kiwanis, Jaycees, etc.
- Homeowners Associations.

### **Class 5 –**

This class of use is for all organizations not meeting the definition of Class 1 through 4 classifications. Any activity of a profit-making organization conducted for the purpose of donating profits or proceeds to the District or to a public charity does not change the rate from this schedule. They will be charged the established use fee for the room/facility utilized and any other personnel or other out-of-pocket costs incurred by the District.

- Commercial or profit-making organization or individual regardless of the purpose of their use.
